



“We’ve got to pull this community together, and the opportunities have to be available for the next generation... Making them understand what their responsibilities are to the community. Making them understand what the functions of the various organizations are in this community. Making them understand that they have a role to play, and if they don’t have a role, then there is no community... How do you make them understand that you have to maintain organizations within the community that require funds?... I think that whether you believe, whether you use, whether you’re a beneficiary or not, you have an obligation to support.”
